

# Announcement of Thammasat Business School Thammasat University

Scholarship Aid for Students Affected by Coronavirus Crisis (COVID-19)

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With reference to the recent coronavirus 2019 pandemic (COVID-19), which has been spreading rapidly and directly affecting world citizens as well as the Thammasat community, the TBS management team has decided to establish a scheme to assist and provide relief for those students adversely affected by the outbreak.

## TBS Relief Scholarship

This scholarship aims to provide financial assistance to Bachelor's degree (International Program), Master's degree and Doctoral program students at Thammasat Business School both in semester (2/2019) and trimester systems (3/2019). There will be 150 subsidies available consisting of 2 types based on the degree of affliction: 5,000 THB and 2,500 THB.

#### Requirement of applicants

- 1. Student in a Bachelor's degree (International Program), Master's degree or Doctoral program at Thammasat Business School.
- 2. Having been directly affected from the coronavirus 2019 pandemic (COVID-19) such as being an infected patient as stated in the TBS announcement, affected by the resulting economic crisis.
- 3. Having demonstrated good behavior without being on any prior principle punishment as stated in the university regulations and having strictly obeyed the university's protocol in preventing the spread of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19).
- 4. Has been affected within semester 2/2019 or trimester 3/2019 period.

#### Required documents for registration

1. Application form: "Scholarship Aid for Students Affected by Coronavirus Crisis (COVID-19)".

2. One of the following letters to prove that the applicant has been affected by the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak:

2.1 Medical certificate (in case that you or your family members have been infected).

2.2 Proof of self-quarantine

2.3 Proof of being suspended or laid off (in the case that you work and study at the same time)

2.4 If you are unable to provide any of the letters above, please provide evidence of the affect that you and/or your family have endured in no longer than 1 page of A4. Include any certified letters or emails from advisors or other evidence proving that you have been economically affected.

2.5 A copy of your citizen card

2.6 A copy of a Bangkok Bank passbook (front page) in the student's name

## Method of Application

Students can send the application form and other documents via the online platform at https://bit.ly/3ef2giq starting from now until April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

## Method of Consideration

The faculty will consider applicants according to the degree of hardship faced and whether they meet all the requirements as stated in this announcement.
