Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 19 (COVID-19)

(Issue 8)

Pursuant to the current situation of the new round of COVID-19 infection in various provinces of Thailand, which has spread rapidly and infected a high number of patients, Thammasat Business School, Thammasat University is extremely worried of its personnel and students. In order to reduce the possibility of further infection of COVID-19, the faculty would like to ask all lecturers, staff members, and students to follow the following guidelines:

1. Work implementation at the faculty, at home, or in temporary accommodation must depend on the head of each department's consideration under the condition that there must be less than 50 percent of the total workforce in each division and that the working period shall proceed under the normal individual time stamp. Any staff who implement work at home need to send a WFH report to the faculty. Above all, implementing work from home must not affect the main responsibilities and effectiveness of staff operations.

2. Any activity required by lecturers, staff members, or students within the faculty area must first seek a request for approval together with details of the measurements in place for the prevention of COVID-19 to the Dean or a person in charge in order to strictly follow the guidelines of the Ministry of Public Health and the University.

3. For lecturers, staff members and students who use the faculty area:

- Always wear a face mask at all times
- A temperature test must be passed before entering the university buildings. The test is located in front of the elevators both at Tha-prachan and Rangsit campuses. If anyone fails the test or exhibits signs of infection, please immediately see a doctor for a further diagnoses and report back to the faculty.

This announcement has been made for all personnel who use the office or the faculty area to strictly follow these public health measurements on the prevention of COVID-19 in order to show social responsibility and to prevent the virus from further spreading.

The announcement is effective between 7th – 30th April 2021.
