Measures and Recommendations for the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 19 (COVID-19)
(Issue 18)

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Following Thammasat Business School's announcement on the Measures and Recommendations for the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 19 (COVID-19) (Issue 17), given on 29th Dec 2021 (effective from 1st – 31st January 2022), Thammasat University would like to issue an emergency announcement on the guidelines for teaching and learning after the New Year holiday in accordance with the possibility of a wider spread of the coronavirus disease. Consequently, Thammasat Business School, hereby, issues the following measures and guidelines for all lecturers, staff members and students:

1. Thammasat Business School's Measures and Recommendations for the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 19 (COVID-19) (Issue 17) is now cancelled and the new guidelines are as follows:

1. 1 Reimplementation of the work from home method as appropriate with the deliberation of work except work which needs to be carried out within the university/ office. All personal are requested to follow the Ministry of Public Health's measures. The discretion of each staff members' working shifts is the responsibility of heads of departments and must not **affect workload, teaching and learning management, or the efficiency of work**. It is essential that staff who work from home report to the faculty.

1. 2 Teaching and learning methods must follow Thammasat University's guidelines for learning and teaching for semester 2/2021. Methods for teaching can be adjusted to an online platform to secure public health as a priority as long as they follow the conditions stated in item 3 of this announcement.

2. Any support staff members who work overtime should send a request to the faculty. In the case that any staff need to work overtime, either at home or at the office, please keep to the recommendations as stated in the memo dated 11th November 2021.

3. Other measures should be strictly implemented as stated in Thammasat Business School's announcement on the Measures and Recommendations for the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus 19 (COVID-19) (Issue 15) item 2 – 8, including other Thammasat University notifications and announcements from related government sectors to show social responsibility.

This announcement is effective from the 4th until 31st January 2022 unless otherwise declared.
